

## Mr. Rémy Prud'homme

Emeritus Professor,  
University of Paris XII

**Session Title:** Era of Infrastructure: Bangladesh Context as Keynote Paper Presenter.

Professor Emeritus at the University of Paris XII, he was educated at HEC, at the Faculty of Law and Economic Sciences of the University of Paris, at Harvard University, and the Institute of Studies Policy Paris. He earned a doctorate in economics in 1963 and in 1964 passed the contest of aggregation Faculties of Law and Economics in economics. He taught at Phnom Penh University, Lille, Paris XII, where he is stationed at the Institute of Urbanism of Paris since 1977 and at MIT (Massachusetts Institute of Technology) where he was invited as visiting professor several times. From 1974 to 1976 he worked at the OECD as Deputy Director of the Environment Department. He also worked as a consultant for most major international organizations (UNESCO, the United Nations Centre for Human Settlements, the European Economic Communities, EBRD, UNDP, the Asian Development Bank, and more frequently for World Bank), for various governments and local authorities as well as private groups. He also participated in many committees or commissions as the PEON Commission, which prepared the nuclear power program of France, or the Planning Committee of the Territory 8 th Plan, of which he was rapporteur.
