- ★ To prepare Economic Policy Papers (EPPs) for conducting policy advocacy for the benefit of the business sector;

- ★ To prepare, implement and evaluate projects for entrepreneurship development and to deliver time bound, need-based and diversified services to the business community;
- ★ To help women entrepreneurs to promote and expand their businesses.

BANGLADESH ECONOMY: A BRIEF OVERVIEW

Despite stable global economic growth, trade is becoming less open, policy uncertainty is escalating, and geopolitical tensions are intensifying. Nevertheless, Bangladesh's economic outlook remains optimistic, with steady growth expected in the near future. According to the World Bank Group, the country has demonstrated a strong track record of growth and development, even amid heightened global uncertainty. Over the past decade, the country has maintained an average annual growth rate exceeding 6%, driven by a favourable demographic dividend, resilient export performance, steady remittance inflows, and sound macroeconomic management. More recently, the country has witnessed a notable political transition, prompting renewed efforts to re-strategize the economy and mobilize resources toward equitable and sustainable development.

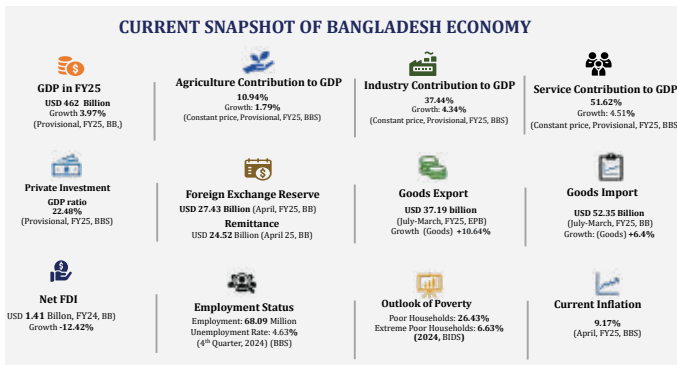
The country has already witnessed a notable surge in mega infrastructure projects such as the Padma Bridge, Dhaka Elevated Expressway, the third terminal of Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport, the Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Tunnel, and the Metro Rail which are already exerting a significant impact on the country's economic activity. These transformative developments have contributed meaningfully to trade facilitation, business growth, and broader socio-economic progress. With the launch of the Metro Rail, Dhaka has joined an exclusive group of 205 cities across 61 countries that operate modern urban rail transit systems.

Besides, the construction of the Rooppur Nuclear Power Plant is a major milestone for the country to become the 33rd nuclear power country in the world. Furthermore, the successful launch of the US-based satellite internet service provider Starlink, a subsidiary of Elon Musk's SpaceX is another significant milestone in boosting the country's economy by providing breakthrough telecommunications services to all citizens. Recognizing the progress of Bangladesh, Time Magazine termed Bangladesh as an economic rising star for its remarkable transformation in the 21st century. Exploiting opportunities from these infrastructures and connectivity is expected to boost investment and employment, potentially leading to a stable growth rate in FY25, steering the economy smoothly towards the ultimate goal of becoming a developing economy by 2026. The GDP for FY25 is expected to be USD 462 billion and the per capita GDP reached approximately USD 2,671, which is relatively significant, according to the Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS), Appendix (Table-2).

Economic Growth and its Key Sectors

Bangladesh's economy has demonstrated notable resilience and strong growth in the post-pandemic era, with real GDP expanding by 6.94% in FY21 and 7.10% in FY22.

The recovery was driven by significant progress in the industrial and service sectors, supported by robust domestic and international demand. However, growth moderated to 5.78% in FY23 and 4.22 in FY24 and the slowdown was driven by a sharp contraction in export growth and subdued investment. Rapid investment activity reflected high inflation and the resulting contractionary Monetary Policy, higher energy prices, and import restrictions. On the supply side, the growth of agriculture, industry and services have declined in FY24. Despite these challenges, the moderated growth is expected to be 3.97% in FY25, as per provisional estimates from the Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS).



Per capita national income is expected to reach USD 2,820 in FY25, which is a record-high per capita income. The domestic savings (gross) and national savings are also expected to contribute to 23.25% and 29.01% of GDP respectively for the same period. The gross investment is expected to be 29.38% of GDP in FY25, with public investment accounting for 6.90% and private investment for 22.48% of GDP, respectively.

The economic achievements are reflected in the GDP ranking of the world. According to the “World Economic League Table-2025” projected by the Center for Economics and Business Research (CEBR), Bangladesh will be the 23rd largest economy in 2034. IMF also said sustained structural reforms are required to achieve Bangladesh’s goal of reaching upper middle-income country status by 2031. Diversifying exports, attracting more foreign direct investment, and strengthening governance are key effective factors in the coming years.
