Profile of Dhaka Chamber of Commerce & Industry

BANGLADESH ECONOMY: A BRIEF OVERVIEW

The economy of Bangladesh has performed well in comparison to many developing countries despite having global economic slump due to the Coronavirus pandemic. In 2020, Bangladesh was marked as the 3rd largest performing economies. In FY2021, Bangladesh secured \$416 billion GDP with 6.94% gross domestic product (GDP) growth having \$2591 per capita income and became one of the fastest-growing economies in Asia while many developed and developing economies underperformed. Economy has consistently progressed with 7% growth for few years until Covid hits backed by strong economic fundamental, compounding export and growth in many socioeconomic fronts. Stagnation of the world economy has constituted some challenges to the economy. However, resilient economic leadership and firm mindset of Government enabled and steered the sharp and V shaped recovery in the economy of Bangladesh. Based on the ongoing spree, the interim macroeconomic report shows the GDP growth of Bangladesh is 7.25% with \$2824 per capita income till March for FY2022. The following economic state highlights the perspective of FY2020-21 as complete and actual economic status of FY2022 has not been fully reported yet.

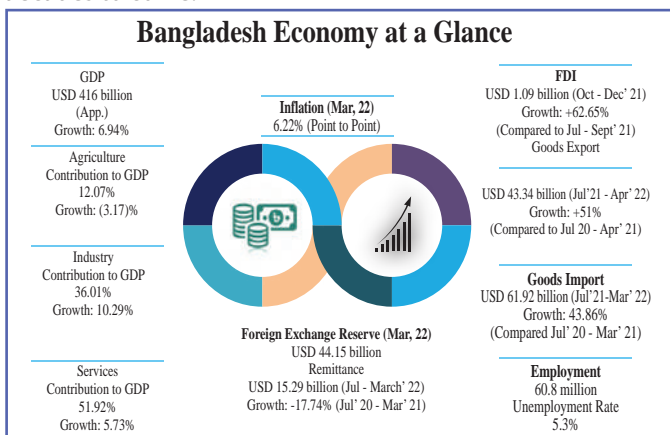
Economic Growth and its key Sectors

Bangladesh economy has been consistently performing well with above 6% of GDP growth since FY2010-11 to up until COVID-19 outbreak happens. The growth rate was elevated to 7.88% in FY2018-19. Unfortunately, country's economic growth trend slightly slowed due to impact of COVID-19 pandemic. In FY2020-21, the real GDP growth rate was 6.94% which was 3.45% in previous fiscal year.

Per capita GDP and per capita national income stood respectively at US\$2,462 and US\$2,591 in FY 2020-21. The domestic savings (Gross) stood 25.92% of GDP, and national savings stood at 33.03% of GDP for the same period. The gross investment stood at 32.32% of GDP in FY2020-2021 where public and private investment accounted for 7.64% and 24.68% of GDP, respectively¹. The economic achievements of the country are reflected by the GDP ranking of the world. Bangladesh is now the 38th largest economy in terms of GDP and 30th largest economy in terms of PPP of GDP.

If the current trend of economic development in Bangladesh continues, it will be the 24th largest economy in the world by 2036, according to the Center for Economics and Business Research (CEBR), a UK-based economic research organization. And, IMF also projects Bangladesh will exceed many developing economies like Netherlands, Thailand Singapore, Denmark, UAE and Malaysia by 2025 hitting the US\$500 billion GDP benchmark. This projection shows tremendous economic potential of the country in the decades to come.



The growth rate of major sectors in constant price is given below for portraying the scenario of macro-economy.

Agriculture

In FY2020-21, contribution of this sector to the GDP was 12.07% which was 12.52% in FY2019-20. During FY2020-21, the contributions of major agricultural sub-sectors like crops and horticulture, animal farming, forestry and related services and fishing to GDP reached 5.70%, 1.98%, 1.75% and 2.64% respectively in contrast to 5.96%, 2.06%, 1.78% and 2.71% in FY2019-20².

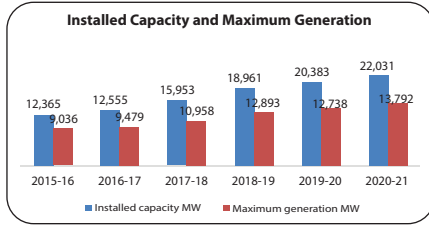
Industry

Industry share of GDP is 36.01% in FY2020-21 which was 34.94% in previous year. The main contributor to the industry's share in GDP was manufacturing at 23.36 % in FY 2020-21, up from 22.40% in the previous year. Electricity, Gas, etc. shared of GDP is 1.25% which was 1.22% in FY2019-20.

Electricity and Power

Government has undertaken immediate, short, medium and long-term plans to meet the increasing demand of electricity and also targets 60000 mw power generations using both renewable and non-renewable energy with priority in clean and renewable energy by 2041. The installed



generation capacity of the country has increased to 22031 MW in FY2020-21 including captive and renewable energy from 12365 MW from FY2015-16 whereas it was 20,383 MW in FY 2019-20.

Service Sector

Service sector grew by 10.82% in FY2020-21 compared to 8.82% in the previous fiscal year. In FY2020-21, service sector share was recorded 51.92% whereas it was 52.54% in FY2019-20. The growth of Wholesale & Retail Trade, accommodation and food service, transportation and storage were 9.09%, 12.89% and 12.49% respectively compared with 6.54%, 7.35% and 6.54% in the earlier year. Financial & insurance sector increased by 11.91%, which was 10.63% in previous year. The overall growth of real estate sector reduced reached to 9.84%, while in previous year the total growth of this sector was 10.47%³. The service sector is expanding as economy is largely dependent on diverse type of services.

Monetary Sector

Private sector credit growth stood higher at 11.29% (y-o-y) in March 2022 compared to 8.79% (y-o-y) growth at the end of the same month of the previous year⁴. In December 2021, the weighted average deposit rate dropped to 4.07 % from 4.09 % in September 2021. In the same period, the landing rate remained unchanged at 4.38%⁵. Industrial loan disbursement during October-December of FY2021-22 increased by 13.78% to US\$2.18 billion as compared to US\$1.94 billion during October-December of FY2020-21. Cottage, Micro, Small and

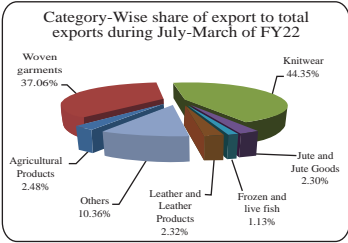

Medium Enterprise (CMSME) loan disbursement by the Banks and NBFIS has increased by 16.61% during October-December of FY2021-22 compared to the same period of the preceding fiscal year⁶.

Export

The export volume in July-April 2021-22 increased by 35.14% to US\$ 43.35 billion in contrast to US\$32.07 billion in July-April 2020-21. In July to March of FY22, RMG export experienced 35.98% growth. The export of readymade garments (knitwear and woven garments) has contributed the lion’s share (81.41%) of the country’s export. During July-March 2021-22,

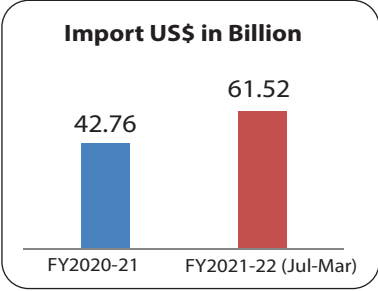

the highest export was 44.38% in the EU, followed by 19.73% in USA, 2.77% in Canada, and 2.70% in Japan⁷.

Import

Bangladesh imported a variety of goods worth \$61.52 billion during the July-March of FY2021-22 which is 43.86% more than the same period of the previous fiscal year goods worth \$42.76 billion⁸. This increase was driven by mainly petroleum & petroleum products, industrial raw material, intermediate goods, consumer goods, capital machinery and machinery for miscellaneous industries.



Balance of Payment

Due to higher import and export growth, trade deficit increased to US\$24.91 billion in FY21-22 (till March). Current account deficit increased to US\$14.07 billion from US\$5.55 billion in earlier year⁹. The overall balance of payment

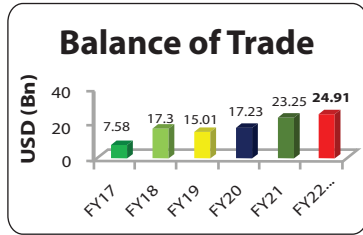

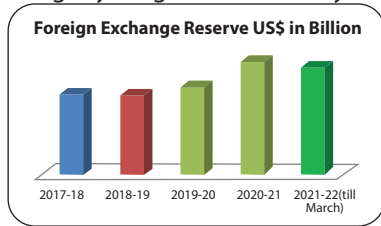

stands US\$2.26 billion (till February) in FY22 from overall balance US\$3.16 billion in FY21.



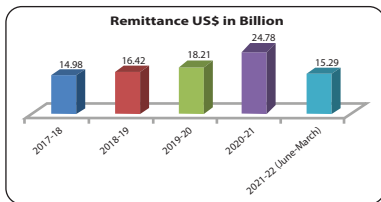
Foreign Exchange Reserve

As of March, FY 2021-22, Foreign exchange reserve of Bangladesh stood at \$44.14 billion which was 1.61% more than the corresponding period of previous year's \$43.44 billion (Bangladesh Bank)¹⁰ though it was 46.39 billion in FY2021 as import trade was slightly insignificant in that year. Bangladesh was capable of paying import bills for 8.39 months with foreign exchange reserves exceeding \$48 billion in August 2021. In February 2022, foreign exchange reserve stood at \$45.95 billion.



Remittance

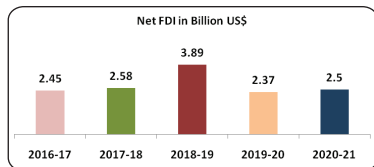
Remittance is a pivotal source of bagging foreign exchange earnings for Bangladesh. During July-March of the fiscal year 2021-22, remittance inflow stood at \$15.29 billion which was more than 17% less than the corresponding period of previous year's \$18.59 billion¹¹.

Foreign Direct Investment (FDI)

FDI net inflow reached US\$ 2.5 billion in FY2021 which was US\$ 2.37 billion in previous year, recording 5.5% positive growth.
